

ATTENDEE INFORMATION

The Oaks Camp and Conference Center

We are excited to have you at The Oaks for your upcoming retreat! Here are a few helpful things to know before you arrive.

Directions

- The Oaks Camp and Conference Center, 18651 Pine Canyon Road, Lake Hughes, CA 93532.
- At the top of the 1/2-mile driveway into camp, you reach a stop sign at a small intersection; turn left here to proceed towards the office, lodging, meeting rooms, and dining.
- If your group leader communicated a location to meet and check-in, use the map below to proceed to that location. If not, go to the office (located on the east end of Lodge 100) during business hours to be directed.

General Information

- **Quiet hours:** Camp quiet hours are observed from 10:00 pm through 7:00 am. You may still be out and around camp during this time, but we just ask that you respect residents and other guests by keep noise down during this time.
- **Internet access /cell service:** There is Wi-Fi access in lodge buildings, Hayford Hall, and Rosey Dining (during meal times). However, being in the mountains, our internet can be unpredictable. Regarding cell service, please note that aside from AT&T, other cell carriers have limited to no connectivity at camp.
- **Onsite assistance:** If any questions arise while onsite, you can first go to your group leader. If they are unavailable, you can call The Oaks host phone number which will be located on every door sign.

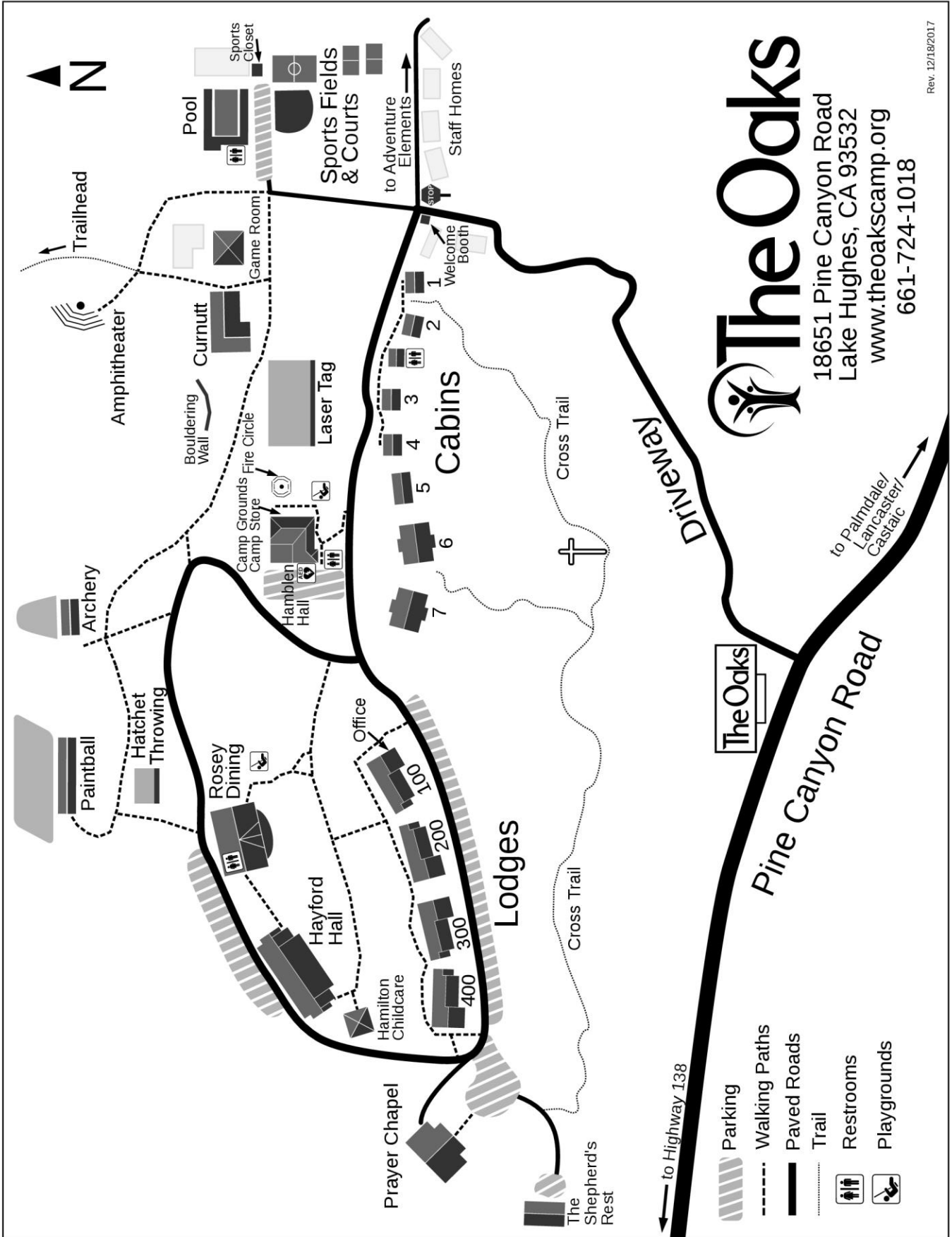
What to bring

- Ask your retreat leader whether you need to bring bedding or not.
- Many locations around camp require walking to get to and from, so bring a comfortable pair of shoes and a flashlight for after dark.
- If you're coming in the summer and your group reserved the pool for swimming, please note that men are required to wear board shorts or trunks (no speedos), and women are required to wear one-piece bathing suits.

What not to bring

- Weapons (including knives), drugs, or alcohol.
- Cooking appliances. These are not allowed in the lodging or meeting rooms. However, there is a complimentary coffee and tea bar as well as a microwave available in the meeting rooms and lodges for your convenience.
- Your pets. Other than certified service animals, we do not allow pets onsite.
